### Bank balance

### Bonfire night

Bonfire night made £472.32 – high insurance costs – no complaints this year to the parish council. Is it necessary to be a school event or can it be passed to the community. Risk assessment done and everything mapped out, parish council meeting before hand to address any concerns. But it is a huge amount of work for PTFA.

Discussion around whether this could be passed to another group within the village? We will ask others in the community for their ideas as to how we can continue the tradition. Perhaps we don't have any food.

### REQUESTS FROM SCHOOL

£200 for non fiction books related to the new history and geography topics – APPROVED.

PTFA paid £200 to a photographer for the website but no other invoice has been received. J to send email to school.

No request has been received for the coach to residential – it is for £100 per child.
